DESCRIPTION :-

Jazan Economic City occupies 117 sq.km of prime land along the southern Red Sea coast, just 60km northwest of the City of Jizan. The development comprises a major seaport with heavy and light industrial components that are complimented by commercial business district, residential and community components. The residential variety offers island, seafront and waterfront living with amenities such as marina, golf course, healthcare, exhibition and convention centre, workers housing, recreational, parks and sports facilities. The light industrial component features food processing, silicon processing, chemical, pharmaceutical, agritech, plastic and textile industries while the heavy industrial component comprise steel processing, oil refinery, aluminium smelter, power and water desalination plants.

Notable features of the urban infrastructure include the utilization of water sensitive urban design concept, stormwater best management practice (BMP) for flood control and improved water quality, water management strategies that ensures maximum water conservation and utilization, optimized earthwork design, centralized sewerage, effluent recycle system and dual water distribution system that offers cost efficiency and supply reliability.
